WG3 Innovative e-dictionaries: Work plan 2015-2017

Working Group 3 (WG3) has 129 members from 27 different countries.

Background

The original proposal for COST Action IS1305 specifies a number of topics that will be dealt with within the Action in Working Group 3. These are:

- Description of the workflow for corpus-based lexicography (Bolzano July 2014)
- Overview of existing software needed in this workflow (Vienna, February 2015)
- Dictionary Writing Systems (and Corpus Query Systems) (Vienna, February 2015)
- Analysis of the possible impact of automatic acquisition of lexical data (distributional thesauri etc.) (Herstmonceux, August 2015)
- Analysis of the interface between dictionaries and computational lexica (cf. wordnets) and syntactically and semantically annotated corpora (Framenet, Semcor, Senseval) (Spring 2016)
- Investigation of possible use of dictionary content for computational linguistic applications (Autumn 2016)

The meetings of WG3 have been (and will be) organised around these topics, each meeting dealing with one theme/topic. For each meeting one or two key persons are identified who are responsible for the organisation of the meeting. Surveys have been used and will be used to gather information from WG3 members on the different topics.
