Alejandro Benito Santos who is employed at the University of Salamanca (USAL) is a researcher, who stayed at our institute from 14 - 18 November 2016.

Before the STSM, a team of experts in visualization at University of Salamanca, in collaboration with the Digital Humanities Center at the Austrian Academy of Sciences, created a visual analysis tool to interactively explore data coming from the *Datenbank der bairischen Mundarten in Österreich* (DBÖ).

During the STSM, one of the main aims was for Alejandro to get acquainted with the recent data format (TEI standard) and its particularities, as well as discovering new processes and key artifacts used by lexicographers during their work, so the tool could better be adapted to the actual needs of the research processes.

A series of steps were followed throughout the STSM, which include understanding the peculiarities of non-standard RDF and TEI formats, analyzing artifacts and work flows used by lexicographers in their daily work, carrying out live analysis/coding sessions and extracting user stories. During his stay, the different stakeholders were able to identify and refine several user stories that will be converted into software requirements, which in turn will be coded as features in the next version of the visual exploration prototype currently being built. The user stories were created with COST WG4 members of the ACDH, Eveline Wandl-Vogt, Amelie Dorn, Caitlin Gura and Barbara Piringer.

The results of this STSM are presented and discussed during the COST WG4 meeting in Budapest. COST members will become acquainted with prototypes, creating user stories and making use of visual analysis to further Pan-European lexicography.
