Report:

The general framework for this mission is the work group European Roots, that has been created within ENeL's WG4 (see <https://sites.google.com/a/campus.ul.pt/european-roots/> for further information).

European Roots is meant to test a lexicographic model for simple roots in a large number of languages and its capacity to provide cross-linguistic information, which is crucial to deal with lexical variation in Europe.

This specific mission was designed to provide a training opportunity for testing the model with the description of Polish roots. This goal is now fully achieved and the description of the Polish equivalents for anger and red is now completed.

When we discussed the work program for this mission (applicant and host), we came to the conclusion that we should foresee some kind of output and therefore we decided to produce a joint paper. The subject of this paper is a comparison between six colour names in Polish and Portuguese (a further account of this paper is provided by the applicant's report). My colleague Esperança Cardeira, who is also a ENeL member will also co-author this paper, that has been fully sketched during this mission and will probably be completed before the Landlex meeting that will be held in Lisbon, in November 2016.

To sum up, this short mission was, in my opinion, adequately programmed and very satisfactorily accomplished.
